### How to Submit your Entry

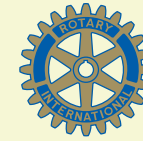
In a large sealed envelope enclose:

## AWARDS AND PRIZES IN 10 CATEGORIES

The Rotary Club of Stirling Photographic Exhibition is open to all photographers, with the opportunity to enter mono- or coloured prints in ten categories:

- 1 Spirit of the Hills** *sponsored by the Adelaide Hills Council*  
A photograph that represents the unique spirit of the lifestyles or livelihoods of the Adelaide Hills.
- 2 People** *sponsored by the Stirling Hotel*  
Where the character of people are the dominant subject. This can include portraits, people in action and crowd scenes.
- 3 Landscape** *sponsored by Sequoia Wealth Management*  
Any photograph of natural scenery including land, sea, or sky. It may include some evidence of people, animals and structures, provided that these elements do not dominate the photograph.
- 4 Digitally manipulated** *sponsored by the Crafers Copy (and Print) Centre*  
Any image where the content of the original scene has been changed or other images imposed in some way.
- 5 Still Life** *sponsored by Gardiners Real Estate*  
Arrangements of fruit, flowers and other non-moving life forms, from studied combinations to those in a natural setting.
- 6 Animals that Capture our Hearts**  
*sponsored by Avenue Road Veterinary Surgery*  
Any image of pets, other domesticated animals or wildlife found in the Adelaide Hills.
- 7 Heritage of the Hills** *sponsored by Mt Lofty House*  
A photograph of any natural feature or man-made structure which is clearly at least 100 years old and which reflects some aspect of the heritage of the Adelaide Hills.
- 8 Nature Matters (under 18 years old)** *sponsored by the Friends of Woorabinda Bushland Reserves*  
Any image of the natural environment or efforts to preserve it.
- 9 Gardens** *sponsored by the Mt Lofty branch of the National Trust, SA*  
Images taken of or in gardens, native or other.
- 10 Open** *sponsored by the Rotary Club of Stirling*  
Any photographic image including, but not limited to, those which do not entirely meet any of the other category descriptions.

### Entry Fees

\$10.00 (\$5.00 student & concession) per photograph entered in any category.

### Competition Rules

- Photographs which do not comply with the relevant category criteria, at the sole discretion of the organising committee, will be relegated to the “Open” category.
- In the Heritage of the Hills category it is suggested that evidence of the age of the subject be provided if the subject is not clearly more than 100 years old.
- Entrants in Environmental Photography category to be aged under 18 years as at 20 April 2016.
- In keeping with the family-friendly nature of the competition and the location of the exhibition photographs may be deemed, at the organising committee's sole discretion, to be inappropriate for public display (e.g. nudity). Such entries will, nevertheless, be eligible for judging.

### Judging

A panel of experienced judges will be appointed. The decisions of the judging panel are final. No correspondence will be entered into concerning the decisions of the judging panel. All winners will be notified by telephone and published on [www.stirlingrotary.org.au](http://www.stirlingrotary.org.au)

### Proceeds

All net proceeds of the Competition and Exhibition will go towards local community projects.

### Responsibility Waiver

The Rotary Club of Stirling will take all reasonable care of exhibits but will not be responsible for any loss, damage to or mis-delivery or non-delivery of any exhibit. The organising committee, at its absolute discretion, reserves the right not to display any image.
