Terms and Conditions for Exhibitors

The Rotary Club of Stirling (RCS) welcomes your participation in the 2020 Small Acreage Field Days. To ensure that your company is clear on the arrangements for participation, these terms and conditions outline the responsibilities of the Rotary Club of Stirling, the Echunga Recreation Grounds Committee (ERGC) and our Field Day Exhibitors.

1. The Exhibitor acknowledges and agrees to be bound by these terms.
2. The Exhibitor shall have licence to occupy the site(s) as nominated during the period of the event. They do so at their own risk, are responsible for the condition of that site(s) and for the safety of visitors and their employees while visiting the site.
3. At the conclusion of the event on Sunday 5 April 2020 the exhibitor shall clear the site(s) within 24 hours of the closure of the event and shall reinstate the site to the same condition at commencement of the satisfaction of RCS.
4. Security will be provided from noon, Friday, 3 April to Monday, 6 April, 2020 however RCS and the ERGC shall not be responsible for the loss of or damage to the Exhibitor's property during the event including during the set-up and take-down periods.
5. RCS at its discretion may refuse any site application.
6. RCS shall have the right to nominate the situation of the site(s) applied for by the Exhibitor.
7. In the event of fire, flood, inclement weather, the declaration of a catastrophic day, or for any other sound and prudent reason, the RCS, through its appointed officials, may at its entire discretion, cancel or postpone the event and this license shall cease to operate upon notice to that effect being served on the Exhibitor. The RCS shall not be liable to the Exhibitor for any compensation on the grounds of loss of profits or otherwise in respect of such cancellation or postponement and the Exhibitor shall not be entitled to any refund or payment of any money paid by the Exhibitor in relation to the licence.
8. All Exhibitors must have a minimum of \$10 million Public Liability Insurance and attach a copy of their "Certificate of Currency" to the application form.
9. Officials appointed by the RCS shall have the right to enter upon the site (s) of any Exhibitor at any time and remove any article, sign, picture, or printed material which in the opinion of the official is either not eligible for display or may be the cause of offence.
10. The use of amplifiers or loud speakers by an Exhibitor should not negatively impact on other Exhibitors. RCS officials shall have the right to order the level of amplification to be reduced to a level acceptable and the Exhibitor is bound to comply with the official's direction.
11. The Exhibitor agrees that 50 percent refunds are given for a cancellation made in writing at least 21 days prior to the first scheduled day of the event and that no refund is made on cancellations by the Exhibitor within 20 days of the commencement of the event.
12. In order to minimise disruption and to ensure the safety of persons on the site, after the commencement of the event each day, no machinery, vehicles, heavy equipment or other articles being displayed shall be removed to or removed from the Exhibitors stalls before the advertised close of the event. Emergency vehicles will be exempt to this provision.
13. In order to protect the surface of the oval, heavy machinery or vehicles with rib tyres will be allocated to areas on exhibitor areas adjacent to the oval. The down weights must be used to secure tents and no pegs will be permitted.
